**Topic: TRANSCENDENTAL MEDITATION –
Dr. Kofi Kondwani**

Kofi A. Kondwani, Ph.D., is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Community Health and Preventive Medicine and a consultant to the National Center for Primary Care at Morehouse School of Medicine in Atlanta Georgia, USA. He is the course facilitator for the Introduction to Complementary and Alternative Medicine elective and directs the Meditation Clinic in the Department of Family Medicine. Dr. Kondwani received his Ph.D. from Maharishi International University in Fairfield, Iowa. Dr. Kondwani has served as the Transcendental Meditation (TM) treatment provider in four randomized clinical control trials supported by the National Institutes of Health, Department of Defense and the National Center for Complementary and Alternative Medicine. These research projects have investigated the physiological, psychological, and behavioral effects of meditation on hypertension and cardiovascular disease and stress reduction. Dr. Kondwani has taught meditation techniques as a preventive and treatment strategy for more than twenty-five years in hospitals, health clinics, schools and businesses.
